News:

- Peer Review Panels (PRP) commenced in July: Trusts' multidisciplinary perinatal review teams evaluated each
 others in-house SCOR reviews for quality assurance purposes further PRPs will be following in the Autumn
- The PRP emphasised the importance of all pertinent information (e.g. conditions, dates, gestation, time) being entered into the **Key Points** at the end of each page so that the case 'story' is clear in the *Case Summary* tab
- The PDN part of SCOR will be used to submit West Midlands perinatal death notifications to MBRRACE (previously CMACH/CMACE), to avoid duplication

Additional features for next upgrade:

- Access to all named Trusts / Boards identified in the PDN pages (i.e. when there has been a transfer of care) if you
 can see new cases from other Trusts, you will need to complete / add information to all relevant questions e.g.
 baby transfer Neonatal and General tabs; mother's antenatal care Booking, Antenatal and General tabs
- 'Additional Points' tab has been renamed 'Review Summary'
- The trigger for the 'Late Booking' risk factor has been fixed
- New questions:
 - o Q1 in General tab (Communication & Documentation) on escalation management
 - o Q9c in General tab (Staffing and Resources) on local policies reflecting national guidelines
- Cause of death has been added to the Case Review (Grade) tab identified in PDN (Baby) tab
- Downloadable reports from Trust's collective data:
 - o General Taxonomy Themes
 - Types of Deaths

N.B. Please note that all reports are currently prototypes and may be altered in line with feedback

The upgrade is anticipated to be on Thursday 9th August when SCOR will be briefly off-line from 10.00 to 13.00 pm

Changes planned (for autumn upgrade):

- More downloadable reports for individual Trust's collective data including specific themes (from the taxonomies) and demographic information
- Changes to the Case Summary (Case Review) and Neonatal tabs
- Automatic notification of anticipated **password expiry** on entering SCOR web site (instead of by email)
- PDF printing options (full and summary) will include Action Plan and Review Summary details
- More detail will be available in the 'Last Updated' button (right side of the Blue banner) so that you will be able to see what changes have been made (as well as who has made changes and when)
- There will be a text box in the Case Review tabs for Peer Review Panel Comments
