# SCOR Pilot Update 11<sup>th</sup> November 2011

#### Total number of SCOR cases entered to date: 23

#### Current use:

- Most units are getting used to completing SCOR now and are taking less time to input data. We would like to commend the units with teams completing SCOR that include midwifery, neonatal and obstetric input.
- Multi-disciplinary communication and specialist knowledge is crucial in order to obtain accurate results and to make pertinent action plans. It is therefore important to **remember to complete the names (and designation) of the review team** on the *Case Review* tab following the overall grade allocation.

## Key new features in today's new deployment:

- Easily visible search results on the *Browse* tab *via the* new *Show* button displaying cases that have been commenced or had data added to them
- Ability to print the Perinatal Death Notification part of SCOR (button in PDN Baby tab)
  - 'Additional Points' tab in the Case Summary section with:
    - Additional review / extra information text box to be used if needed
    - New table to input good practice points
- New question on attendance at Day Assessment Units within the Antenatal tab (question 13)
- New question on supervision within the General tab (question 13)
- Automatic log-off after 15 minutes inactivity on SCOR

Forthcoming functions (due for completion in November/December 2011)

- Print out of SCOR
- Action plan
- Downloadable reports for each Trust's collective data
- Ability to combine data where there has been care across Trusts
